PROJECT IDEAS

- Create a powerpoint presentation; include the title, author, setting, characters, summary of main plot
- Write a book promo for the WVMS News
- Create a poster advertising the book; include a short summary that will intrigue the reader, but not give the plot away
- Create a video about the book or a book trailer advertising the book
- Dress as a character from the book and perform a soliloquy as written by the character; this may be filmed or performed live for the class.
- Design and create a book jacket, writing a summary that will intrigue the reader, but not give the plot away
- Make a time line of the events that occurred in the book; be sure to include pictures that relate to the events
- If the book has been made into a movie, write a compare/contrast essay about the movie and the book
- Write a newspaper article about an event that occurred in the book
- Create a comic book about the book
- Write a poem or a rap about the book
